<u>Design</u> Technology

Our DT work will be based on Tudor houses, linked to our History topic. We will sew a Christmas decoration to sell at our Cracking Christmas. Event.

<u>Music</u>

The children will learn how to listen to and appraise a variety of songs. They will improvise using voices and instruments. They will learn a wide range of musical vocabulary and use these words correctly when answering questions.



<u>RSHE</u>



We will be learning about how our actions can contribute positively to the life of the classroom. We will use a range of words to describe our feelings and recognise that people have different ways of expressing their feelings. We will understand how to deal with feelings and explain where someone could get help. We will learn how to identify ways that friends care for each other and will learn the difference between bullying and isolated unkind behaviour.





<u>English</u>

Some of our Literacy work will be based on our 'Read, Write, Inc' books each week. Additional Literacy work will include poetry, lists and captions, non-chronological reports and writing narratives. We will have a particular focus in the first half term on punctuation and grammar, preparing the children for writing.





A variety of topics will be covered including: Year 1: Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, and Shape. Year 2: Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, and Shape.



Dance—The children will be practising a dance based on dinosaurs, varying levels and speed and linking movements together.

Gymnastics—Children will be practising and performing a sequence, linking rolls, jumps and balances.

Games - The children will be refining their passing and receiving skills through a variety of small, competitive games, taking the lead in their activities and challenging themselves where appropriate. <u>History</u>

In the first half of the term, children will learn all about The Great Fire of London—how it began and why it spread so quickly. We will also learn about the Gunpowder Plot

<u>Geography:</u>

We will be learning about the world's continents and oceans in the second half of the term.

RE We will learn about what who Christians think made the world. We will learn how to order the different days in the creation story. We will also learn about Harvest and celebrate Harvest Festival at the church.

In the second half of term, we will learn about the Nativity story and why Christmas is important to Christians. Children will learn to identify the parts of the body and we will learn about each of the five senses. During the second half of the term, we will focus on animal families and learn the difference between mammals and birds. We will also be able to distinguish between amphibians, reptiles and fish. We will discover the types of food living things eat and explore the difference between wild animals and pets.



We will be focusing on painting skills, using a variety of painting tools and linking this with our class topics for the term.

Computing

E-safety - protecting my friends and family and knowing what can be seen on-line and who by.

We will be learning how to use a mouse and track pad to control a computer. We will learn how to drag objects. We will focus on finding letters and numbers on the keyboard to type words.
