ParentPay

Payments for Breakfast and After School Clubs - To bring us into line with Trust's protocols for processing income, we are introducing a new payment system for Breakfast and After School Clubs. We are no longer able to accept payments on a pay-as-you-go basis. We will also no longer be sending home weekly reminders of outstanding amounts.

All parents will now be invoiced monthly in arrears, and the invoice should be paid in full through ParentPay. This will reduce the amount of cash being handled in school. **PLEASE NOTE: We cannot accept payments in advance for Breakfast Club and Kids Club via ParentPay.** If you still have an outstanding balance for February, this will have been invoiced last week, and the outstanding balance will be on ParentPay for you to settle. If your child has attended Kids Club and/or Breakfast Club from 28/02/20 you will be invoiced at the end of March.

We are now also able to take payments for school uniform via ParentPay, so please sign up now if you have not already done so. *Please see Mrs. Coates with any questions or queries. Thank you.*
