English

Some of our Literacy work will be based on our 'Read, Write, Inc' books each week. We will also learn how to write an explanation text, and a set of instructions. Our poetry will focus on riddles. In the second half of the term we will focus on writing a narrative and persuasive writing.



Maths

A variety of topics will be covered including:

Year 1: Multiplication and Division, Fractions. Position and Direction, Money, Time

Year 2: Fractions, Time, Statistics, Position and Direction



PE

Athletics —Children will learn how to run at different speeds for different distances, jump over hurdles and throw a range of implements.

Games - The children will learn how to send and receive a ball using a racket, working on their accuracy. They will use the skills they have learned and apply them in a team game.



History

The children will be learning about the history of Crowan School and the surrounding village of Praze.

Geography:

We will be comparing and contrasting Cornwall with a non-European country.

Science

Children will be learning that seeds grow into plants and will learn how to identify the basic parts of plants and trees. We will learn the difference between deciduous and evergreen trees, and will learn that fruit trees and vegetables are varieties of plants. We will plant seeds and measure the growth of our plants.

Art

In the second half of the term, we will be focusing on our use of fabric to create different pieces of art work.
