Spring Term



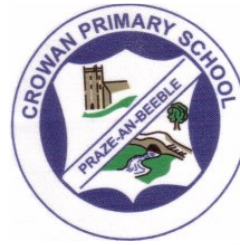


Literacy

Fiction - We will be learning the story of 'Goldilocks and the three bears', innovating and inventing our own stories based on this.

Non-fiction - We will write an information text as well as instructions on how to make a pancake.

Through this term the children's writing targets will be on **Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar**.



Numeracy

A variety of topics will be covered including: Addition and Subtraction, place value within 50, length and height, weight and volume (Year 1). Multiplication and division, statistics, properties of shape, and fractions (Year 2).

Through this term the children's maths targets will be on **Reasoning and problem solving skills**



PE

Gym - To identify different body parts for bearing weight, to practise ways of moving, and to link balances with travelling movements. We will be concentrating on stretching and curling movements.

Games—rolling a ball to hit a target, throwing and catching with increasing accuracy, controlling and kicking a ball, and striking a ball with a bat.

We will use these skills to play team games.



History

In the second half of the term we will be learning all about the Great Fire of London, how the fire started, why it spread so quickly and the effects of the fire. This will be linked to our Geography topic of 'Bright Lights, Big City.'

Science

In Science, we will be learning about 'Seasonal Changes'. We will learn about the four seasons and predict what might happen as winter turns to Spring.

We will learn about the effect of the seasons on trees, weather and on animals.



Art

We will be learning about motifs and exploring texture, line, shape and space. This will be linked to our Science topic of 'Seasonal Changes'.



Computing

E-safety - protecting my friends and family and knowing what can be seen on-line and who by.

Children will be learning how to use a mouse and track pad to control a computer. They will learn how to find numbers and letters on a keyboard and type words.



RE

We will learn about forgiveness through the parable of the lost son. We will learn about the Easter Story and why Christians celebrate Easter.

We will also be exploring how Jewish people live.
