Music

This term we will be taught by our Music specialist teacher Miss Judge teaching us the ukelele. In Spring 2 we will be learning the Charanga unit 'Lean on Me'.



PSHE

Keeping safe— we will be learning the difference between danger, risk and hazard, including staying safe online and in different social situations and understanding how to use medicine safely.

Rights and respect— who keeps us safe, our rights and responsibilities, how we can be involved in making rules to keep us safe and how the media can influence us.

French

We will be learning how to name and say different fruits we like or dislike, then in Spring 2 we will begin the 'Je peux' unit of 'I am able' saying 10 different verbs they can or can't do.

<u>Design</u> <u>Technology</u>

Textiles – cutting, shaping, joining, finishing techniques

We will research, design and refine, explore different sewing stitches, make and evaluate processes when designing and making our own Roman-inspired coin purses.


<u>History</u> The Romans

We will be exploring the early Roman Empire and why the Romans were important in Britain, including key events during their reign and why they came to Britain and how they conquered (including learning about Boudicca's rebellion against the Romans). We will be comparing Roman and Celt settlements and discovering what they introduced into Britain (such as roads and towns) before seeing what life was like in the South West during Roman times. Finally we will think about their legacy and what they brought to Britain that influences many of the things we have in our society even today.









Literacy

Fiction - we will be looking about how to add characterised speech within a narrative.

Non-Fiction - we will be writing persuasive letters.

Poetry—we will be learning limericks, including their structure and rhyming pattern.



Numeracy

Year 3 - Multiplication and Division B, Length and Perimeter, Fractions A and Mass and Capacity.

Year 4 - Multiplication and Division B, Length and Perimeter, Fractions and Decimals A.



Science

Forces and magnets — through a variety of experiments, we will be exploring contact and noncontact forces, comparing how different objects move on different surfaces, and exploring the various types of magnets, their properties, uses (including everyday objects) and whether all metals are magnetic or not.



Computing

Online safety— we will be understanding and explaining why things on-line can upset us and other people and what I can do about it? We will learn why we only talk to people we know in the real world as people can pretend to be someone else online.

Digital Art— we will learn how to copy, paste and rotate to create patterns and symmetry in an animated

GIF computer game graphic.



Islam—we will be learning about how festivals (such as Ramadan) and worship (such as the Qur'an, prayers, mosques) and their family life shows what matters to a Muslim?

Judaism—we will be learning about festivals (such as Shabbat, Rosh Hashanah, Yom Kippur and the story of Passover) and how they celebrate these and their family life shows what matters to Jewish people?



PE

Dance—we will be performing a rainforest-inspired dance as part of a group creating movements of an explorer and animals with a tribal feature.



Striking and Fielding — we will learn to strike and field with more accuracy and work as part of a team.

Swimming—in Spring 2 we will be going to learn various swimming strokes at Penryn School.

Gymnastics— we will create a sequence by linking a jump, roll and balance neatly on the floor and apparatus.

Geography

Mountains—we will be thinking about why mountains are important to the Earth and people who lives near them, including how they are made, where they are found in the UK, how to protect them and what sort of jobs people living in mountainous areas can do.

Art

Painting - seasons and weather

Developing understanding of colour through mixing warm colours, using sgraffito techniques and mixing tones of grey.
