After great feedback and people saying they would take part Praze Cricket Club have decided to launch its very own Praze Scarecrow competition for the villagers of Praze.

As this is the first year we have decided on the theme "Movies".

This will be held over Praze Fair Week with scarecrow builders paying an entrance fee (£5) and the public purchasing maps of the scarecrow locations (£2) and being able to allocate marks to their favourites. Entry's can display their creations in the front garden, driveway or inside the window facing out for people to see.

On Sunday 13th July people have the chance to walk around the village and follow the map provided where all the entrants can be found to score each entry. Voting forms can be collected from the cricket field pavillion from 0930 in the morning. Final votes must be in by 1500 at the cricket field pavillion for the final count.
