Music

The children will learn how to listen to and appraise a variety of songs. They will improvise using voices and instruments. They will learn a wide range of musical vocabulary and use these words correctly when answering questions.




PSHE

English

Some of our Literacy work will be based on our 'Read, Write, Inc' books each week. Additional Literacy work will be linked to our 'Toys' topic—a character description, a recount and an information text. We will also be writing shape poems/calligrams.

Gymnastics—Children will be practising and performing moving in different directions and in straight lines, linking movements together in a sequence.

Games - The children will be practising their throwing and catching skills. They will learn how to aim a ball with increasing accuracy. Children will learn how to hit a ball with a bat. They will use the skills they have learnt and apply them in a team game.



History

'What can we learn about toys from the past?'

Children will compare and contrast their toys of today with those of their parents and grandparents.

Geography:

We will be learning about our local area of Praze—creating maps and learning how to give directions.



We will be learning the differences between things that are living, dead, and things which have never been alive. We will learn how to identify and name a

variety of plants and animals in a microhabitat and design a suitable microhabitat

where living things could survive. We will look at food chains and explore the

journey our food makes from farms to supermarkets.

We will be focusing on painting mixing colours and creating textures. We will look at the artist, El Greco, and will use this to inspire our own art work.

Computing



E-safety - Children will
learn what the Internet is and what
people use it for. We will discuss
what personal information is and why
it should be kept private. Children
will learn where to go for help and
support if they are concerned about
something they see online. We will
learn why it is important to respect
people online.

We will also be learning about computer programming with Junior Scratch.

RE

We will learn about what Christians believe God is like. We will look at various parables and learn about what they teach Christians about what God is like.

In the second half of the term, we will learn about why Easter is important to Christians.
