Measles

Following a rise in cases across the country (we currently do not have any cases in the school) we have been asked to share the following information with you by Cornwall Council.

Following recent cases of Measles, The UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) warns the virus can spread very easily among those who are unvaccinated, especially in nurseries and schools. Measles can be a very serious disease, leading to ear and chest infections, fits, diarrhoea, and damage to the brain. Measles usually starts with cold like symptoms followed by a rash.
